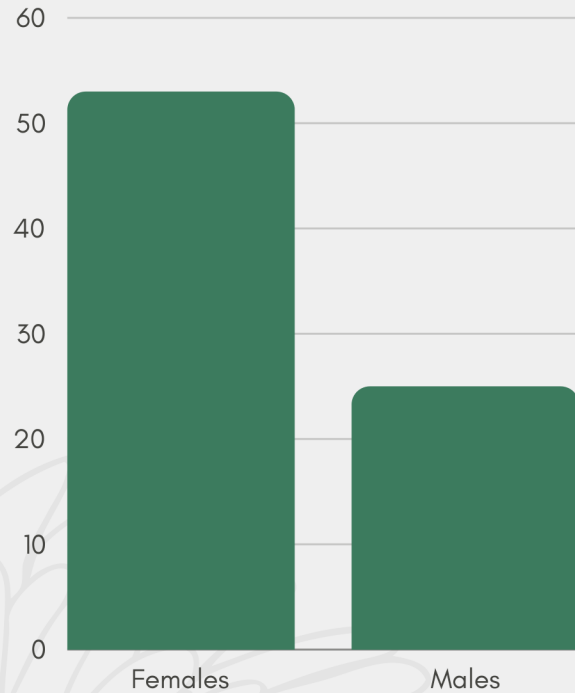

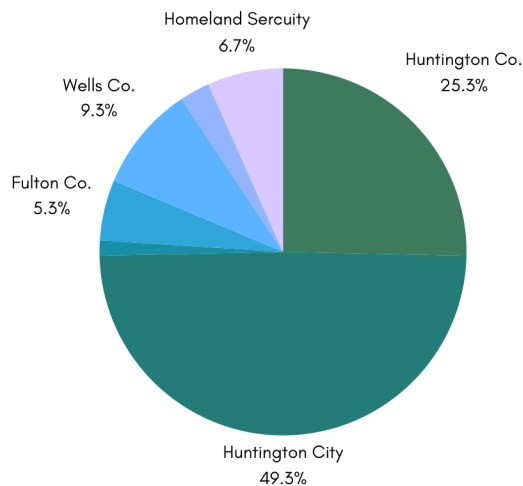

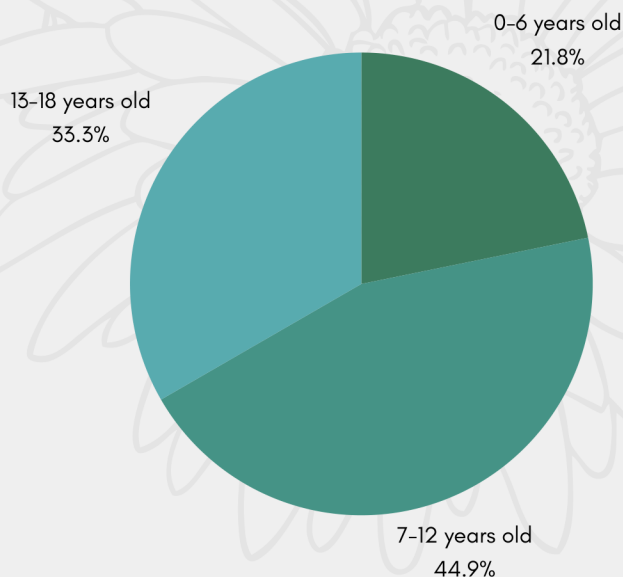
Clients by Gender
